The Theology of the Body Institute presents "Theology of the Body and Priestly Prayer," the second of a three part retreat-seminar series entitled, "In the Person of Christ: Theology of the Body and the Catholic Priesthood." Guided by Father Cliff Ermatinger, priest participants will walk the road to Emmaus in the presence of Christ to rediscover the path of prayer in the light of the Theology of the Body. Participants will contemplate and discuss among brother priests, the joys, challenges, and opportunities for prayer inscribed in the heart of their priesthood. Topics will include discernment of spirits, spiritual warfare, contemplation, lectio divina, Marian receptivity, praying the liturgy and more. Join your brother priests for a unique time of discussion, deep prayer, reflection, and daily celebration of the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Confession that will rekindle both your prayer life and your love of the priesthood.



Father Cliff Ermatinger is a native of Chicago and is currently pastor of St. Anthony of Padua Parish in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. He was ordained in Rome in 1997. He has lived and worked in Germany, Hungary, Mexico, Spain, Italy and Ireland where he has preached missions, taught the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises, and worked as spiritual director. He is active in the ministry of Exorcism while training other priests to become exorcists. He is the author of numerous homiletics and articles, as well as six books including: *Letters from the Desert: Two Centuries on Prayer in the Byzantine Tradition*, *Following the Footsteps of the Invisible: The Complete Works of Diadochus of Photike and St. Therese of Lisieux: Spouse and Victim*. Father Cliff attended Theology of the Body I: Head & Heart Immersion course in 2007 and is co-author of the *Theology of the Body and Priestly Prayer Curriculum*.

- Time for relaxation and prayer at the St. Mary of Providence Retreat Center in Elverson, PA (50 miles northwest of Philadelphia).
