Immaculate Virgin Mary, mother of our Lord Jesus and our mother,
we have confidence in your powerful and never-failing intercession,
manifested often through the Miraculous Medal.

We your loving and trustful children, as you to obtain for us
the graces and favors we ask during this novena,
if they will be for the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

O Mary, conceived without sin,
Pray for us who have recourse to you.

Day One: We pray for those who haven't understood their identity as male or female. May persons generously give of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can help men and women come to know their identity as a son or daughter of our Heavenly Father.

Day Two: We pray that husbands and wives will live the beauty of the Sacrament of Marriage. May persons generously give of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can promote the truth and beauty of living marriage between a man and a woman.

Day Three: We pray for all parents who strive to pass on the Catholic Faith to their children. May persons generously give of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can assist parents become more nurturing of their children through the healing they receive through the teaching of St John Paul II and through authentic loving experiences with Jesus Christ.

Day Four: We pray for all families that they fully understand true family life as revealed to us by our loving Father. and His Church. May persons give generously of their God-given resources to TOBI, so they can prayerfully assist families in becoming domestic "churches," loving homes that reflect the love and life of the Blessed Trinity.

Day Five: We pray for all bishops and priests, especially those struggling with their priestly identity and prayer life. May persons give generously of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can assist priests to be re-infused in their relationship with Jesus Christ through a deeper understanding of their spiritual fatherhood and authentic celibacy for the Kingdom through the spousal meaning of their bodies.

Day Six: We pray for all the youth in the world, that they “be not afraid” of God, the Church or their faith. May persons give generously of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can assist young people to know the truth of their dignity as children of the Father and prayerfully direct them to a Spirit-led discernment of their vocational calling.

Day Seven: We pray for all the parishes and dioceses in the world that they be re-enlivened spiritually to become vibrant communities of reverential worship and faithful teaching. May persons give generously of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can assist parishes to be communities rooted more deeply in our covenantal relationship with God.

Day Eight: We pray for the media, so often driven by secular cultural ideology and agenda. May persons give generously of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can inspire the world of art, music and media to see in freedom the true, good and beautiful in human persons as a reflection of the Creator.

Day Nine: We pray for all of God’s people, enshrouded in the darkness and confusion produced by the culture of death. May persons give generously of their God-given resources to TOBI, so it can help promote a culture of life and love rooted in the authentic teaching of the dignity of all human persons given to us by the Church through Pope St. John Paul II.
